General Assembly Nominations (Manual Appendix E, pg. 140)

1. Senator Nominations

- a. Your County should divide by party – the 3 City Central Committee Chairwomen shall preside. (*Pink Stickers - Chairwomen only*)
- b. Nominate citizens from your party who want to run for the Senate. This is a state office; thus, you may not run for any other office if elected. Attendance at all Senate sessions is mandatory.
- c. Elect your party's slate of three (3) Senators.
- d. **FORM 4S** is to be filled out in duplicate by the City Central Committee Chairman and Secretary. **Please print and use the candidate's first and last names as they appear on her name badge.**

2. Representative Nominations

- a. Regroup by City, then divide by party within each city. Each City Central Committee Chairwoman presiding. (*all pink stickers vote*)
- b. Nominate citizens from your party who want to run for the House of Representatives. This is a state office; thus, you may not run for any other office if elected. Attendance at all House sessions is mandatory.
- c. Elect your party's slate of four (4) Representatives.
- d. **FORM 4R** is to be filled out in duplicate by the City Central Committee Chairwoman and Secretary. **Please print and use the candidate's first and last names as they appear on her name badge.**

*Citizens are encouraged to take notes about the candidates. These notes can be taken to the polls to assist in voting.

3. Elect County Central Committeewomen

- a. Divide by party; within your party, divide by ward (white numbered stickers).
- b. Elect two citizens within your ward to serve as County Central Committeewomen; these County Central Committeewomen also will be responsible for gathering names from respective cities of those interested for candidacy at the county level and will meet Monday afternoon to slate the County Ballot for their party.

County Central Committeewomen will receive an Orange Sticker to denote their position

- c. **FORM 6** is to be filled out by the City Central Committee Chairman and Secretary. **Please print and use the candidate's first and last names as they appear on her name badge.**

City Counselors MUST upload a copy of Forms 4S, 4R and 5 immediately during this meeting prior to placing the information on BASIS for Ballots.

4. Campaigning

- a. Regroup as a County
- b. Each candidate for Senate may give a short speech.

*Citizens are encouraged to take notes about the candidates. These notes can be taken to the polls to assist in voting. You should wrap this up by 2:15pm to leave time for your city council meeting.
