Dear ALA MGS 2025 Citizen:

Congratulations on your selection as a citizen to the 2025 session of American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) Missouri Girls State (MGS). As many have said in the past, the memories you make at ALA MGS will be with you forever. We hope to provide you with experiences this summer to equip you in your future studies and careers. ALA Missouri Girls State will be held on the campus of Lindenwood University in St. Charles from Saturday, June 21 to Saturday, June 28, 2025.

The 2025 session of American Legion Auxiliary Missouri Girls State will hold many exciting opportunities for our participants. The ALA MGS Committee has been working tirelessly with Lindenwood University to ensure that you have a premier experience this session, and we can't wait to share the week with you. The 2025 session of ALA Missouri Girls State will mark the program's 83rd session, and the program's fourth session co-hosted with The American Legion Boys State of Missouri at Lindenwood University. While both programs have their own scheduled events and opportunities for their citizens, there will be speakers and educational opportunities that Boys State and Girls State citizens will attend together. ALA Missouri Girls State citizens and staff will have their own residential facilities, dining hall, and program headquarters for the duration of the program. The 2025 session of ALA Missouri Girls State will, once again, be a phenomenal experience for all involved!

Registration is from 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, June 21st in your assigned residence hall at Lindenwood University. On Friday, June 20, you will receive an email with your assigned residence hall. This will allow you to check in at your specific residence hall. We will also be able to assist you upon arrival if you do not know your assignment.

We would like all citizens to be registered and moved into their residence hall by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 21 so the program can begin on time. The ALA Missouri Girls State program will assign a preferred window of time for arrival at registration to accommodate the volume of individuals checking in at one time. Please try your best to arrive during your assigned time window, but if it is not possible, do not feel like you can't come! This is **your ALA Missouri Girls State**, and we want everyone to arrive safely. If you cannot arrive by 3:30 p.m., call the ALA MGS program at **628-252-6471**. When possible, please limit the number of people that you bring with you to registration to one parent/guardian per ALA MGS citizen.

Two (2) or three (3) hours of political science college credit will be offered by Lindenwood University to all ALA MGS citizens who successfully complete the week. One of the University's requirements is participation from Saturday's first meeting to the following Saturday's last assembly/city meeting. This is one of the reasons that all citizens must attend the **entire** session to be eligible for completion of the program and college credit.

To ensure that all citizens and alternates receive the same information prior to attending ALA MGS 2025, **all citizens and alternates are required to attend an orientation about the program.** In our program's Code of Conduct, which you acknowledged upon applying for ALA Missouri Girls State, we note the requirement of completing an orientation prior to June 11, 2025, in order to attend our program. **Any citizen who has not completed the orientation process prior to June 11th will forfeit the opportunity to attend the ALA MGS program.** Your school or ALA Unit sponsor will be notified should you fail to meet this requirement.

We acknowledge that many families feel more comfortable attending an in-person orientation and have scheduled multiple orientations for this purpose. We also understand that not all citizens will be able to travel to one of these face-to-face options, so there is also an online orientation as well. You can choose to attend an in-person orientation at one of the scheduled events listed below. If you cannot travel to an in-person orientation, you will be required to attend one of the six online options on the specified dates. The orientation dates and locations are included in this mailing.

Finally, the **Citizen Information Packet** is ready to download from the ALA Missouri Girls State website at www.missourigirlsstate.org on the "2025 Session Info" tab. The packet contains documents that must be completed and brought with you on Saturday, June 21, along with crucial information for a successful week. Upon receiving this letter, you should download and print this packet to review with your parent or guardian. Please note that the Citizen Information Packet includes information about applying for ALA Girls Nation and the ALA Samsung Scholarship. Both opportunities require significant work that cannot be completed in the final week or two prior to the session.

Please follow our social media accounts listed below in order to get any other updated information. We will also send emails on a weekly basis to the citizen and parent address included on the citizen's application. These emails will be sent via the iContact email service and may appear in your promotions/spam/junk folder the first time, so please check it accordingly!

Your path to success at ALA Missouri Girls State 2025

- Download the Citizen Information Packet at www.missourigirlsstate.org and review it with your parent or guardian!
- Orientation – each citizen is required to attend an orientation by **June 11, 2025**.
 - o Option 1: Attend an in-person orientation on the dates listed on the reverse side of this document.
 - o Option 2: If you cannot travel to an in-person orientation, complete the online orientation option available on the specified dates. The link for the orientation is available on the “2025 Session Info” page of our website.
- Check your email regularly for program updates, transportation information, and assigned registration times. ***Some of these weekly email updates will include surveys that you must complete in a timely manner.***
 - o One of these surveys, we will ask those living outside of a 90-mile radius of Lindenwood University about your choice for bus transportation to and from the session in these surveys, which is offered at no additional cost to you.
